Day 1:

Day 5:

Departure for a full day tour with your personal guide to the medieval village of Saint Emilion listed as a UNESCO World heritage site ...enjoy a visit of the region's wine chateaux and discover how the grape from the vineyards is transformed into the amazing wine in your glass. Overnight at the Hotel La Maison Bord'Eaux.

Day 6:

Today, indulge yourself and forget the rest of the world. Enjoy the opportunity to experience the popular and unique Vinothérapie spa, Les Sources de Caudalie, in the heart of the vineyards. The treatments are absolutely unique: they combine the virtues of naturally deep warm spring water, rich in minerals and oligo-elements, with vine, grape and grape seed extracts...Truly unforgettable. Overnight at the Hotel Les Sources de Caudalie.

Day 7:

Departure for the scenic Bay of Arcachon, an inland sea with the colors of a lagoon and a wonderful nature reserve. Discover charming villages exuding a pleasantly rustic atmosphere, taste the most popular and best oysters of France. Stop in the attractive town of Arcachon, a seaside resort erected on the shores of a protected coastline, where light takes extremely delicate shades. If you are looking for something amazing, ascend the breathtaking Dune du Pyla, the highest sand dune in Europe. From its summit, the dune offers a unique panoramic view over the Bay, the Atlantic Ocean and the forest – all at the same time! A magic moment at sunset... Day 8:

Take your time today to travel down the coast to the Basque Country and visit the city of Bayonne, famous for its ferias, its bullfighting and its ham. This city, surrounded by mountains and ocean, is very attractive because of its picturesque 16th century houses, its amazing cuisine and its festivals. Overnight at the Hotel l'Ostape.

Day 9:

Journey to the interior countryside of the South West, specially the Basque Country, rich in historical, natural and cultural heritage. Take the time to visit the little town of Dax, one of France's top spa towns, with its hot springs and mud baths. Between the beaches of the Atlantic and the Pyrenees, Dax is a delightful town, located at the gates of the Basque country and a stone's throw away from Spain. Discover the colorful markets, savor the culinary delights and enjoy the richness of the spa water. Overnight at the Hotel l'Ostape.

Day 10:

Enjoy your last day in the vibrant cosmopolitan town of Biarritz, former residence of the Emperor Napoleon III. Discover why the imperial couple fell in love with this surprising and charming town. Overnight at the Hotel du Palais.
